



Going to the Festival

1



Arrive at the Miami-Dade Cultural Center Plaza and register at HistoryMiami Museum's check-in tent.

2



Check-in with museum staff. There may be a line to wait in. At check-in, our staff will ask for your tickets to scan. You will receive a wristband to wear.

3



The festival may be crowded with lots of people. You might hear music and other sounds. It might be loud.

4



There will be some activities at the festival that you can do. You can make art with Zot Artz or do other craft activities.

5



You can see a performance or demonstration. You may have to wait for them to begin. The audience might clap. The clapping may be loud.

6



You can listen to story time or play musical instruments.

7



If you get hungry, there will be food and drink vendors outside on the plaza. There may be a line to wait in.

8



There are a few different exhibitions inside the Museum to visit. Some may be brighter, and some may be darker than others. Some may be cold. Some might have music, high-pitched buzzing, or other sounds.

Some things in the Museum are for touching. Some things are only for seeing or hearing.

If you need a break, you can leave the festival activities and come back later. There are quiet corners inside the Museum or you can visit the library across the plaza to sit quietly inside the Quiet Room.
